ROCO Season Opener features dynamic guest conductor, JoAnn Falletta, and string bass soloist, Sandor Ostlund

River Oaks Chamber Orchestra (ROCO) opens its 2010-2011 season by welcoming back guest conductor **JoAnn Falletta**, who will conduct Mendelssohn's *Symphony #3*, Ligeti's *Concerto Romanesc*, and the world premiere of **Scott McAllister's** *Rhapsodie for String Bass and Chamber Orchestra* performed by ROCO principal bass, **Sandor Ostlund.**

Called "one of the finest conductors of her generation" by the New York Times, **Ms. Falletta** serves as the Music Director of the Buffalo Philharmonic Orchestra and the Virginia Symphony Orchestra. She is a vibrant ambassador for music and an inspiring artistic leader, both on and off the podium.

Scott McAllister is Associate Professor of Composition at Baylor School of Music. Dr. McAllister completed his doctorate in composition at the Shepherd School of Music at Rice University. He has received numerous commissions, performances, and awards throughout the United States, Europe, and Asia.

ROCO's principal string bass, **Sandor Ostlund** is in his fourth season with ROCO. Dr. Ostlund is Associate Professor of Double Bass at Baylor University. He is an active and versatile performer as a soloist and as a chamber, early music, and orchestral musician. He has been featured with International Society of Bassists Conventions, as concert soloist with orchestras, in live radio broadcasts, and has premiered several works for solo double bass.
