River Oaks Chamber Orchestra Musician to Perform

River Oaks Chamber Orchestra continues to break barriers in the classical music world with the performance of principle horn musician Danielle Kuhlmann's solo performance at The Tasting Room in Uptown Park on February 3rd. This performance is part of the ROCO introduction of classical music throughout Houston with the combination of classical music and the sampling of fine Merlots (performances are called ROCOCO).

Danielle Kuhlmann, will also be performing on Amateur Night at the Apollo on March 11th singing Toni Braxton's "Unbreak My Heart." Danielle saw an advertisement for tryouts and entered the contest in September and broke through the competition and invited back for Amateur Night. Danielle selected the Toni Braxton song after learning the piece while volunteering in the Philippines the last two years with Cultures in Harmony.

Danielle will be playing the French Horn and performing Bach Third Cello Suite - Bouree I & II, Benjamin Britten Serenade for Tenor, Horn and Strings – Prologue, Messiaen - Appel Interstellaire and David Amram - Blues and Variations for Monk. Tickets are \$100 and seating is limited to forty individuals. She will return to Houston for the River Oaks Chamber Orchestra Third Concert – Conductorless on February 21st at The Church of St. John the Divine (Westheimer at River Oaks).
