ROCO principal clarinet, Nathan Williams, will present a chamber concert on Sunday afternoon, November 13th, at 4:00pm, at Gremillion & Co. Fine Art Annex, 2501 Sunset Boulevard.

Nathan Williams has been hailed by critics as “outstanding for his musicality, breath control, robust, and brilliant tone, and flawless technique.” In addition to playing principal clarinet with ROCO, Nathan is on the faculty of the Butler School of Music at the University of Texas at Austin in August, 2008, and is a founding member of Strata, a trio with pianist Audrey Andrist and violinist/violist James Stern.

This chamber concert is the first in a new series this season. Gremillion & Co. Fine Art, Pisco Portón, and River Oaks Chamber Orchestra have teamed up to feature individual ROCO musicians in intimate concerts at Gremillion & Co.
